NEW: Special Educator Teacher Grants

The Beta Epsilon Chapter of the Delta Kappa Gamma Society International, is offering two \$400 Grants to Burbank USD Special Education teachers.

These grants are for a K - 12 class/school project that targets educational enrichment through the improvement of Special Education learning opportunities and/or learning environments for students. These Grants focus on Special Education self – contained classrooms, which include RSP, SDC, SH, and DHH. It can be in any subject area e.g. language arts, STE(A)M, gardening, communication, library, visual & performing arts, mathematics, etc.

Criteria: A successful application will exhibit the following:

1. A clear outline of the proposal.
2. A proposal that demonstrates a positive impact on the students and the school's instructional program.
3. Exemplifies the applicant's creativity and enthusiasm.
4. A project that can be replicated by other teachers.
5. A project that is cost-effective and includes a detailed budget of expenditures.

Awarding of the Grant

The grant will be awarded based on the information contained in the application. A Beta Epsilon committee will evaluate all applications and select the grant recipients. Successful applicants will be notified by December 6th. Funds will be issued directly to the teacher.

Each project must be completed by May 1st. In addition, each grant recipient will be asked to provide a project summary and an evaluation (250 words or less) for publication in the Beta Epsilon Newsletter or attend a meeting to share their project with DKG members.

Final Date for Submission:
